2 Chronicles 7.14 KJV

If my people which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways: then will I hear from heaven, and forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

- Humble means to submit oneself to another.
- It takes strength to be humble it is not a sign of weakness, because it takes strength to submit and deny your desires to please God.


- Obedient to the sound.
