Positioned for the Impossible
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The Bible says that "For nothing is impossible with God." This was spoken to Mary, the mother of Jesus, by the angel Gabriel in Luke 1. Mary was told she was going to have a baby. That the Holy Spirit would overshadow Mary and the power of God would be upon her to accomplish this.

God moves through what seems impossible to mankind. Signs, wonders and miracles mark the impossible. Impossible means that something is not able to occur, exist or be done – it further means not to have the strength, power or ability or to be too weak to accomplish. Impossible in no way describes our God! He is ABLE! His arm is not too short or too weak. His ways are not man's ways. God's ways are not only supernatural but they are supreme – meaning nothing can overpower the way God does things.



Nothing is impossible with God! The heavens and the earth and under the earth belong to God. Time belongs to God. He was in the beginning and will be in the end. The past and the future belong to God. The nations belong to God. Mankind belongs to God. All of creation belongs to God. Everything is bound to God. **All things are within the power and capacity of God Almighty.**

Mary was positioned for the impossible of God to be demonstrated through her life. Mary was a bondservant of God. This describes her relationship with the Lord before the angel Gabriel visited her. As a bondservant, Mary believed the Lord was able to do anything; she trusted the Lord with all of her heart. Mary put her life into the hands of the Lord – she was not following her own ways but the ways of the Lord. Mary was a worshipper. She knew the Lord deeply and intimately. So when the angel Gabriel came to deliver a message from God to Mary she did not reject the message by intellectualizing what was said. Mary received the word of the Lord just as it was spoken. That means Mary took the word into her heart as truth; she did not take the word into her mind. She did not evaluate or consider the word; she just believed. Her heart was ready to receive because her heart was already yielded to the voice of the Lord.

After Mary received the word into her heart, the power of God came and Holy Spirit overshadowed, or enveloped and covered, the word to perform it. The power of God came on His word spoken to Mary to accomplish it – to make it happen. What would be impossible by any other means became possible through the power of God to accomplish what He says or speaks. Nothing is impossible with God. What He speaks will be accomplished. God is not confined by the laws and ways of creation. He is the Creator. Nothing is impossible for God.

God does the impossible through His people. The Lord is saying 'let passion ignite in your heart'. He wants to work through us to execute His plan in the earth. God is going to speak to our hearts His possibilities. He is looking for hearts like Mary's that will receive His word. God is not looking for minds to plant his word in; He is looking for hearts. We are being filled with the frequency of heaven. Heaven is being drawn to us because we have surrendered our hearts to Him. We are embracing the lifestyle of a bondservant – we are fertile ground for the impossible of God to move through us. Remove restrictions, exceptions, artificial boundaries, human reasoning that would reject the impossible of God. The light of God is breaking forth from within our hearts. NOW is the time and WE are the people.

What impossible things is God speaking to Detroit? To you? To your neighborhood? Your workplace? Over your children? Over the civil government? Over nations? Let the prophetic word, the proceeding word, come fresh to you. Let God remove all doubts and fears. Let Christ rise up in your heart to a fresh and new stature. Be impregnated with the impossible of God. Let the power of God come upon you and the Holy Spirit over shadow you. He will watch over His word to perform it – to accomplish. We are the vessels to carry the word of God.

¹⁰ "You are My witnesses," declares the LORD,
 "And **My servant whom I have chosen,**
So that you may know and believe Me
And understand that I am He.

Before Me there was no God formed,
 And there will be none after Me.

¹¹ "**I, even I, am the LORD,**
And there is no savior besides Me.

¹² "**It is I who have declared and saved and proclaimed,**
 And there was no strange *god* among you;
 So you are My witnesses," declares the LORD,
 "And I am God.

¹³ "Even from eternity I am He,
 And there is none who can deliver out of My hand;
I act and who can reverse it?"



Isaiah 55.8-11

⁸ "**For My thoughts are not your thoughts,**
Nor are your ways My ways," declares the LORD.

⁹ "For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth,
 So are **My ways higher than your ways**
And My thoughts than your thoughts.

¹⁰ "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,
 And do not return there without watering the earth
 And making it bear and sprout,
 And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;

¹¹ So will **My word be which goes forth from My mouth;**
It will not return to Me empty,
Without accomplishing what I desire,
And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.

⁹“Remember the former things long past,
**For I am God, and there is no other;

And I will accomplish all My good pleasure’;**
¹¹ Calling a bird of prey from the east,
The man of My purpose from a far country.
**Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass.
I have planned it, surely I will do it.**



Judges 7.19-22

¹⁹ So Gideon and the hundred men who were with him came to the outskirts of the camp at the beginning of the middle watch, when they had just posted the watch; and **they blew the trumpets and smashed the pitchers that were in their hands.** ²⁰ When the three companies blew the trumpets and broke the pitchers, **they held the torches in their left hands and the trumpets in their right hands for blowing, and cried, “A sword for the LORD and for Gideon!”** ²¹ **Each stood in his place around the camp;** and all the army ran, crying out as they fled. ²² **When they blew 300 trumpets, the LORD set the sword of one against another even throughout the whole army;** and the army fled as far as Beth-shittah toward Zererah, as far as the edge of Abel-meholah, by Tabbath.

- Gideon and his army were filled with the frequency of heaven. They had opened their hearts to receive the impossible of God.
- God performed His word. The enemy was defeated. A new order came.



Exodus 4.29-31

²⁹ Then Moses and Aaron went and assembled all the elders of the sons of Israel; ³⁰ and **Aaron spoke all the words which the LORD had spoken to Moses. He then performed the signs in the sight of the people.** ³¹ **So the people believed;** and when they heard that the LORD was concerned about the sons of Israel and that He had seen their affliction, then **they bowed low and worshiped.**

Acts 16.25-31

²⁵ But about midnight Paul and Silas were **praying and singing hymns of praise to God,** and the prisoners were listening to them; ²⁶ and **suddenly there came a great earthquake,** so that the foundations of the prison house were shaken; and **immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened.** ²⁷ When the jailer awoke and saw the prison doors opened, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself, supposing that the prisoners had escaped. ²⁸ But Paul cried out with a loud voice, saying, **“Do not harm yourself, for we are all here!”** ²⁹ And he called for lights and rushed in, and trembling with fear he fell down before Paul and Silas, ³⁰ and after he brought them out, he said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”

- Paul and Silas were positioned for the impossible of God. They kept their eyes on Jesus. They kept their hearts open and yielded to God. They released the sound of heaven through worship.
- Impossible – an earthquake opened the prison doors and broke off the chains fastened around the prisoners.
- Impossible – the prisoners did not flee or riot or try to escape when this happened.
- Impossible – the jailer and his household were saved.
