The Word of The Lord April 9, 2024 Suzi Armstrong

Psalm 33.4 KJV

⁴ **For the word of the LORD** is right; and all his works are done in truth.

- The word of the Lord – Hebrew meaning – dabar – to say, speak, instruct, direct, report, decree.
 - Also, a technical expression for prophetic revelation.
 - When we decree or declare the word that Holy Spirit puts in our mouth, it carries prophetic revelation.
 - The prophetic revelation in that decree speaks to people, the earth, the angels, and the powers of the air. It is seed and sperm – it goes into what it is targeted for and brings about the purposes of God.
 - We are in a season of revelation, especially about identity, including insight and understanding of God’s identity.
 - He is reiterating who He is. He is sovereign. He is holy. He is good. He is righteous. He is creator. He is judge. He is life.

Psalm 33.9-10 TPT

⁹ **He breathed words and worlds were birthed.**

“Let there be,” and there it was—

springing forth the moment he spoke,
no sooner said than done!

¹⁰ **With his breath he scatters the schemes of nations who oppose him;
they will never succeed.**

- **With His breath He scatters** the schemes and **foils** the plans of darkness.
 - Dissolve, frustrate, annul, divide.
 - To refuse, forbid, dissuade, neutralize, break, disallow, discourage, make of no effect.
- When we speak the word the Lord puts in our mouth it is the spring board for His word to go forth.

John 3.8 NIV

⁸ **The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going.** So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.

- In this scripture Jesus is speaking to Nicodemus about being born of the Spirit.
- Prophetically we can see that God directs the wind and it goes where He wants it to go.
- This is true when we speak the decree of the Lord.
 - The sound can be heard.
 - But you can’t tell where it came from or where it is going.
 - We participate in this through our union with Christ and being seated with Him.
 - We release God’s decree over the top or from above everything else.

The Old Testament records multiple times that the word of the Lord came to Abraham, David, Solomon, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Isaiah, Zechariah, and others. The Bible says that the word of the Lord is eternal.

Below is a record of the word of the Lord coming to Apostle Ron Rayon, that referenced the word of the Lord at the foundations of this State. These Michigan believers were moms, dads, fur traders, leaders, farmers, exploders, and business owners. People who, in the process of living their lives, received the word of the Lord and spoke that word out.

I was at the Capital in Lansing praying on 12/28/23 and I saw in the Spirit the foundation of the State of Michigan. I heard a voice saying **"I laid a foundation for the State of Michigan before it was accepted into the Union of States by and with people faithful to Me and My purpose. My government stones were laid, and no one can overturn them. Your destiny is secured in the former times for these times.** Be courageous and set the seal, My seal, of the Spirit of Life over the spirit of death. Declare that Michigan, My Michigan shall live and not die! So I shouted "Oh Michigan, the Lord's Michigan; you shall live and not die and proclaim the testimony of Christ for the salvation of many yet to be born on you". Ron Rayon an Apostle of Jesus.

Ephesians 1.19-21 NIV

¹⁹ and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ he exerted when **he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,** ²¹ **far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.**

- Ephesians 2.6 tells us that we are seated with Christ far above all wickedness.

Ephesians 3.10-12 NIV

¹⁰ **His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms,** ¹¹ according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord. ¹² In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

- 'Church' is the word Ekklesia – it means a governing body such as a senate. The Ekklesia is to govern by releasing the word of the Lord.
- Note that the word of the Lord referred to by Apostle Ron Rayon was spoken by believers in the land at that time. And the word of the Lord that they spoke carries weight today. The word of the Lord made known the manifold wisdom of God to rulers, authorities and powers of this dark world, against spiritual powers of evil. It carried and still carries governmental authority.
- The word of the Lord is set in the foundation of our State. It was released as a prophetic word and sown into our State.
- God is speaking His word now – He is sending the word of the Lord to those who will hear and speak His word. Know that this is very significant. We are in a new era and God has words He wants released and set into our land at this time.
- This is our part in FirstFruits – to worship God and hear the word of the Lord and speak it over Detroit, its communities, its people, and over our State.
- Detroit is to speak the word of the Lord out to our Nation and the nations of the earth.
- Last week there was a group of people in Michigan who were speaking the word of another god. The word they spoke was 'death to America, death to Israel'.
- The One True God is not speaking death to America or to Israel.
- Psalm 33.4, the word of the Lord is right, and His works are done in truth.

PRAYER AND DECLARATION:

Father, we honor You and declare that You are sovereign and holy. In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. We honor Your word. Your word is a lamp unto our feet and light unto our path. Your word is the governing power behind all things, and You put Your word in our mouth so we, as Your Ekklesia, can speak your word by the power of Holy Spirit.
