⁵ **Trust in the LORD with all your heart**

And do not lean on your own understanding.

- Confident expectation.
- Total reliance.
- Gaze continuously.
- Hope.
- Boldness.

Trusting God is beyond mental assent. Trust is a dimension of relationship. It is a place of encounter. It is complete union with Christ. Trust is a realm that you can abide in. It is a place that you continuously have your eyes and your mind set on the faithfulness of God knowing that He is able and that He is the source of EVERYTHING. Knowing that He is ALWAYS with you – He never leaves you or forsakes you. Trusting God with ALL of your heart means that you have laid down being self-protective. It is a place of complete yieldedness to God with expectation that He will work all things together for the good of those who love Him. In trust nothing can separate you from the love of God – not death or life, angels or demons, neither the present or the future, nor any powers, nor height or depth or anything else in all creation. Trust is passionate believing in God that ignites a fire in your heart making you unmovable by circumstances. It is absolute persuasion that God's promises are "yes" and you speak the "amen". Trust will hold you as you wait upon the Lord so that you can mount up with wings as eagles. Trust is letting go of control and managing your life. In trust your faith is fueled and explosive. Trust has a voice and a language of unbridled hope. Trust does not have limitations and it builds strength to endure and courage to stand and advance. Trusting God with all of your heart extinguishes doubt and all of the what-ifs – shutting the door on the enemy's voice of harassment. Indeed trust is a dwelling place in God where peace prevails. Trusting God is an offensive position giving you the upper hand in any battle. Trust is a prophetic dimension connected to the future. Trust is a place of beauty and light.

continually, for we trust and we wait upon you!**


Psalm 40.3-5 TPT
