Go Through the Door Marked Freedom April 26, 2022 Suzi Armstrong

Excerpt from prophetic word – Prophet Rose Sambrook from Ireland:

Why are you overwhelmed, says GOD? It is because you are not living in the correct realm. Let go and come up higher. Don't stand in the corridors of confusion anymore. I see you looking at doors. Go through the door marked "freedom". Believe and trust Me. Listen for the sounds of the angels marching. They are coming with messages from My throne room – of deliverance, of hope, strategies for the battles. The war is raging – choose to ascend. Operate in your kingdom authority, no longer bound to this realm. Let go of fear, resentment and anger – come up higher. The blood of Jesus is enough.

Go through the door marked "freedom" and come up higher. When I heard this phrase, I thought of Moses telling Pharaoh what God said, "Let My people go!" The Israelites had been slaves to the Egyptians for many generations, now God was going to bring them through the door marked FREEDOM. God brought them into FREEDOM in a very dramatic way; it was a sign and wonder to all of the earth that God is God alone. And that all of the other gods are idols.

Don't stand in the corridors of confusion any longer. No longer be stymied by chaos, fear and intimidation. NOW is the time to make your move – GO THROUGH THE DOOR MARKED FREEDOM! The door is clearly marked.

John 10.9-10 NASB

⁹ **I am the door;** if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

¹⁰ The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came so that they would have life, and have *it* abundantly.

- Jesus is the door. He is freedom.
- When you go through this door you will find pasture – a place of safety and provision.

John 8.31-36 NASB

³¹ So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, *then* you are truly My disciples; ³² and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." ³³ They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never been enslaved to anyone; how *is it that* You say, "You will become free?"

³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly I say to you, everyone who commits sin is a slave of sin. ³⁵ Now the slave does not remain in the house forever; the son does remain forever. ³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you really will be free.

God is bringing us into a place of total freedom as we have already entered into this new era.

- Revelation knowledge is being released in abundance.
- As you advance those things that need to come off are being revealed – step into freedom.
- At you step into freedom you are being newly mantled for this new era.
- We are at the dawn or beginning of this new era – wickedness from the old era is being shaken out.
- New boundaries are being set.
- We are free of the old ways and free to enter the new ways as Holy Spirit leads.
- New faith level.

- New strength – the power to withstand attack.
- New ways to process and think (set free from old structures that captured you and defined how you would live that were full of legalism and control mechanisms).

ENCOUNTER:

During worship with the Resting Place there was such a sweet presence of God. It was thick and heavy. I could feel His tangible love pouring into my heart and soul. It was absolutely wonderful.

AC kept singing that He was holy and worthy. Every time that AC sang through that loop His presence increased. I could feel the heaviness of His presence in my hands. I could taste the sweetness of His presence. As we worshipped, I kept ascending in the heavens. I passed through door after door – doors of freedom.

I had an incredible encounter where I saw the face of Jesus. As I looked upon His face I was captivated by His eyes. I saw the fire in His eyes. As I focused on Jesus' eyes and did not look away, I felt immense passion and love entering my heart as I received the gaze from His eyes. It was life-giving. I was being filled to overflowing with His love and acceptance of me. I was being brought into a greater measure of freedom. I felt very affirmed in Christ. Jesus was strengthening me as I kept looking at Him. My heart was bursting with love. He was beautiful. I was in awe as I stayed in this place. I didn't want it to end. I lingered for a long time. My heart is branded by His love from this encounter. I can look into my heart and reconnect with this new place of freedom and revelation.

This was a powerful encounter that shifted my life. My thinking has changed. I have a new confidence level and new strength. I know the love of God in a whole new way. Nothing can separate me from the love of God and the freedom He gives me in His love.

2 Corinthians 5.14-15 NASB

¹⁴ **For the love of Christ controls us**, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died; ¹⁵ and He died for all, so that those who live would no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose on their behalf.

- Paul is stating that the motivating passion of his life is Christ's love filling his heart, leaving him no choice but to surrender everything to God – TPT footnote.
- This is where the door marked freedom leads.

2 Corinthians 3.17 NASB

¹⁷ **Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, *there* is freedom.**

DECLARATION:

Father we thank You for freedom. Freedom from control and manipulation; freedom to be who we were made to be. Freedom to choose. The blood of Jesus is the power of freedom. Your word leads us through the door marked freedom. That Jesus came to open prison doors and set the captives free. It was for freedom that Christ set us free; therefore we will keep standing firm and will not be subject again to a yoke of slavery.

We release freedom into the atmosphere over our city and nation. We declare freedom reigns in Detroit. Chains of oppression are broken. We speak freedom into the hearts of the people. Where there has been hope deferred – we release hope. Let the exuberance for life that comes with freedom saturate people's hearts. We declare that the spirits of anxiety and fear are broken in the name of Jesus and those that have been held captive are now set free. Let the sounds of freedom, the frequency of freedom that comes from heaven, invade this place like the roar of a mighty waterfall. We speak freedom over our children. Freedom in our communities and in our institutions. **We lift up Jesus that all people might be drawn to Him.**
