God MADE This Day June 20, 2023 Suzi Armstrong

Psalm 118.24 NASB

²⁴ **This is the day which the LORD has made;**

Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

There are two components to every day. There is the natural component that is filled with politics, education, business, family and such. There is also a supernatural component that is from God.

- There is a supernatural reality that is higher than the natural day.
- God has put Himself into every day before we get there.
- **This is the day that God has MADE!**
 - He crafted and created this day – He is the Creator of everything visible and invisible.
 - Everything that He makes carries His life, His fingerprint, His heart, and His goodness.
 - This is a supernatural dimension that is available to us each and every day.
- Here are some of the definitions for the word “made” from Strong’s Concordance – advance, appoint, become, finish, maintain, prepare, provide, have charge of, fashion.
- New grace, new mercies, new provision, new opportunities.
- In each new day that God has made we are being made new.

² For **I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.**

²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. **The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God,** who loved me and gave himself for me.

¹⁴ **Listen to this, Job; stop and consider God’s wonders.**

¹² **Have you ever given orders to the morning, or shown the dawn its place.**

- Consider the wonders of God.
- He gives orders to the morning and He has told dawn its place.

Exodus 13.21-22 NIV

²¹ **By day the LORD went ahead of them** in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and **by night** in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. ²² **Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.**

- Supernatural boundaries set each day that the Lord made as the Israelites went through the desert for 40 years.

These are examples of the supernatural dimension of God that was part of the day He made. God knows the times and seasons in the earth. The above scriptures show that each day that God makes comes with the supernatural provision of God that is needed at the time. God does not make cookie-cutter days. He crafts the day that He makes. He fills that day with provision, understanding, strategy, creativity, opportunity, covering, and more.

The day Jesus met the woman at the well and the day that Jesus healed the woman with the issue of blood and the day that Mary broke the jar of perfume and anointed Jesus – these were all days that the Lord made. The Lord made the day that Jesus was crucified and the day that Jesus was resurrected from the grave. Every day that God has made are marked for us to participate in, to connect with the supernatural dimension of the day that God made, to enter in by faith and partner with God.

There are no ordinary days. Every day is extraordinary because God made it and filled that day with Himself, His power, and His beauty. The natural does not define our day – God does! God infuses meaning into each day that He makes. God has designs for each day. He has a purpose for each day. God is working in the day that He has made, and it is specifically designed for that time. Our days are not happenchance. This day didn't just happen. Everything in your worldview changes when you know that God made this day.

Prophetic words give understanding of the day that God has made. This past Sunday Chuck Pierce prophesied a word: *"I have just heard the Lord speak; I have just heard the Lord speak! All of you turn North – point your hand North. Those on the Northern boundary – set a blood line and set a fire of God on the North. A movement is trying to quench the movement of God. You're being blocked to destruction."*

The Lord is telling us that the enemy is on the move and plans to enter our nation through the Northern border. This is a day to seal the Northern border. Michigan is a Northern state with an international border. Let us agree together that the borders of Michigan are protected and sealed off from this move of the enemy.

PRAYER AND DECLARATION:

We humble ourselves before You and in the Name of Jesus, we declare and decree that the borders of Michigan are sealed shut, especially the Northern border. Sealed from penetration of the enemy plot to kill, steal, and destroy. We ask that any illegal movement across our border be exposed and stopped. We speak confusion and disruption into the camp of the enemy. We apply the blood of Jesus to our state's borders and declare a blood line is intact around Michigan. We ask You, Lord, to be a wall of fire around Michigan and the glory within. We release angels and the hosts of God to our borders to defend Michigan.

We thank You, Father, that Your righteous right arm is extended over Michigan. We lift Your Name up, Jesus, over our borders. Your Name that is above every other name. As the ekklesia we declare that Michigan belongs to the Lord.

We declare Psalm 44.4-8, Psalm 46.1 and Psalm 121.1-2 to our borders and over Michigan:

⁴You are [Michigan's] King and my God, who decrees victories for [Michigan]. ⁵Through you we push back our enemies; through your Name we trample our foes. ⁶[Michigan] puts no trust in the bow, the sword does not bring [Michigan] victory; ⁷but you give [Michigan] victory over our enemies, you put our adversaries to shame. ⁸In God we make our boast all day long, and we will praise your Name forever. ¹God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. ¹[Michigan] lifts its eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from? ²[Michigan's] help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.

This is the day that the Lord has made, and we step into the supernatural provision of God that is needed for this day. We give thanks to our God and King and we rejoice in Him.
