The Tremendous Power of Heartfelt Prayer October 8, 2024 Suzi Armstrong

James 5.16b-18 TPT

...tremendous power is released through the passionate, heartfelt prayer of a godly believer! ¹⁷ Elijah was a man with human frailties, just like all of us, but **he prayed and received supernatural answers. He actually shut the heavens over the land** so there would be no rain for three and a half years! ¹⁸ Then **he prayed again and the skies opened up over the land** so that the rain came again and produced the harvest.

Florida is bracing for a second hurricane in less than two weeks. Florida is still cleaning up debris while North Carolina and Tennessee are still devastated from Hurricane Helene. Many people are still missing. Water, electricity, food, and medical supplies are desperately needed in the mountain areas. Many of us have friends and family that live in these areas of devastation. Our neighbors need help.

God created us to respond to what is going on in the earth – to release His government. Darkness covers the earth. God commands His people – arise and shine.
