### Psalm 24.1 NIV

<sup>1</sup> **The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it,  
the world, and all who live in it**

- This statement declares God's dominion in and over the earth and all that is in it – everything!
- It ALL belongs to Him.
- He is in charge.

### Colossians 2.9-10 NIV

<sup>9</sup> For **in Christ all the fullness of the Deity** lives in bodily form, <sup>10</sup> and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. **He is the head over every power and authority.**

### Philippians 2.9-11 NIV

<sup>9</sup> Therefore **God exalted him to the highest place  
and gave him the name that is above every name,**  
<sup>10</sup> that **at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,**  
in heaven and on earth and under the earth,  
<sup>11</sup> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord,  
to the glory of God the Father.

- All dominion belongs to Him.

### Daniel 7.8-10 NIV

<sup>8</sup> "While I was thinking about the horns, there before me was another horn, a little one, which came up among them; and three of the first horns were uprooted before it. This horn had eyes like the eyes of a human being and a mouth that spoke boastfully.

<sup>9</sup> "As I looked,

**"thrones were set in place,  
and the Ancient of Days took his seat.**

His clothing was as white as snow;  
the hair of his head was white like wool.

**His throne was flaming with fire,  
and its wheels were all ablaze.**

<sup>10</sup> **A river of fire was flowing,  
coming out from before him.**

Thousands upon thousands attended him;

### Revelation 5.12-13 TPT

<sup>12</sup> And as I watched, all of them were singing with thunderous voices:

**"Worthy is Christ the Lamb** who was slaughtered to receive great power and might, wealth and wisdom, and honor, glory, and praise!"

<sup>13</sup> Then every living being joined the angelic choir. Every creature in heaven and on earth, under the earth, in the sea, and everything in them, were **worshipping with one voice, saying:**  
**"Praise, honor, glory, and dominion**  
**be to God-Enthroned**  
**and to Christ the Lamb**  
**forever and ever!"**

Dominion is positional authority and power. It is the power that comes from being the head or over something. It emphasizes the presence and significance of power that has been given with position. In Genesis 1 God gave dominion power to Adam and Eve over all the birds of the air, the fish in the sea and all the creatures on the earth. Dominion power is connected to stature; a king rules over the entire kingdom in every aspect. The Lord is referring to dominion when He says that we are the head and not the tail. He made us to be above and not beneath. Dominion is overall power and strength.

As believers we have been given power and authority. We have been given dominion in the earth – especially over the geographical boundaries that God has set us in. He put us where we are to have dominion. We bring heaven into the earth to bless the land and the people; we demonstrate the Lordship of Jesus Christ. In the realm of dominion power is the love of the Father for all that He has made. His provision, His mercy and His grace are demonstrated in His dominion. The Father gave His only Son because He loved the world so much that through Jesus all might be saved and reconciled. This is dominion! As we lift up Jesus, He draws all mankind to Himself. He brings unity and peace; hope and a future.

**Matthew 10.7-8** NIV

<sup>7</sup> As you go, proclaim this message: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.'<sup>8</sup> **Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give.**

We are not to lose sight of God's dominion power in this time as we see chaos in different cities in our nation – the clashing of cultures. The nations and the cities belong to God. Things may seem out of control and unchangeable, but with one word God can change everything. That is dominion! Dominion is about ownership and who is in charge. Do not lose hope or strength – God is God alone from before time began, He was on the throne! He is and continues to be unchangeable, unshakable, and unstoppable! How majestic Your name is in all the earth! You have set Your glory above the heavens. From the lips of children and infants You have ordained praise because of Your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger. Rescue our nation from the mouth of the lions. O Lord God, who stands in dominion over all of the earth, be a wall of fire around our city and our nation against the invasion of any and every ungodly agenda. Fill our city and nation with Your glory and the wonder of Your name. Let the arrogant and prideful boasts of powers and principalities and wickedness in dark places be silenced. Their voices are hollow and powerless. The enemy has lost strength. Confuse the wicked, O Lord; confound their speech. Destructive forces are at work in the city; threats and lies are in the streets and echo on the airwaves. The terror of death is coming against our land and people. Unrighteous rulers set in the seats of our government; they pass laws that are against the people bringing division and hatred.
