God Is Unchangeable July 9, 2019 Suzi Armstrong

In the prophetic we are looking for the key that will unlock people, unlock culture, unlock the city and open them up. Then we speak out of that place into their God-given identity. The lens of the prophetic is how God sees things. How He sees does not change based upon behavior. How God sees is through His design and plan – His purpose, how He has created it to be. We must see through His compassion, His goodness, His love, His purpose, His timing.

Prophetically God has been saying, "Step in, step into Me. I am what you are looking for. I am what you need. I am your supply. In Me you will find your identity." He has opened our eyes to see Him in new ways with a new depth of understanding and revelation. God Himself will work expansion and increase in and through us. It is not about us stepping into performance and trying to make things happen. Through us God will bring about what He asks of us. He will give us the word to see and the language to speak what we see. Christ in us is the guarantee that we can see like He sees and speak like He speaks. We can hear like He hears. Christ in me is the guarantee that I do not belong to the world or darkness. The prophetic operates through Christ. The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

Ephesians 5.13-14 AMP

¹³ But **all things become visible when they are exposed by the light** [of God's precepts], for it is light that makes everything visible. ¹⁴ For this reason He says,

"Awake, sleeper,
And arise from the dead,
And Christ will shine [as dawn] upon you and give you light."

- TPT says it this way, "whatever the revelation-light exposes, IT WILL ALSO CORRECT, and everything that reveals truth (or reality in Christ) is light to their soul."
- Where the light of God goes, change comes that adjusts and corrects the dynamics.

John 1.4-5 NIV

⁴ In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. ⁵ The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

John 8.12 TPT

¹² Then Jesus said, "I am light to the world and those who embrace me will experience life-giving light, and they will never walk in darkness."

- The Aramaic is "they will never be driven (pushed) by the darkness".
- Light overcomes and supersedes the darkness.

Isaiah 60.1-2 NIV

¹ Arise, shine, for your light has come,
and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.

² See, darkness covers the earth
and thick darkness is over the peoples,
but the LORD rises upon you
and his glory appears over you.

- TPT says it this way, "Rise up in splendor and be radiant, for your light has dawned..."



Philippians 1.6 NASB

⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

- God completes all that He begins.
- Detroit will be what God created it to be.
- Michigan's name means great water. In the Word God says that His voice is like the sound of many waters. Isaiah 46.4-10 NIV

⁴ I am he, I am he who will sustain you.
I have made you and I will carry you;
I will sustain you and I will rescue you.
⁵ "With whom will you compare me or count me equal?
To whom will you liken me that we may be compared?
⁶ Some pour out gold from their bags
and weigh out silver on the scales;
they hire a goldsmith to make it into a god,
and they bow down and worship it.
⁷ They lift it to their shoulders and carry it;
they set it up in its place, and there it stands.
From that spot it cannot move.
Even though someone cries out to it, it cannot answer;
it cannot save them from their troubles.
⁸ "Remember this, keep it in mind,
take it to heart, you rebels.
⁹ Remember the former things, those of long ago;
I am God, and there is no other;
I am God, and there is none like me.
¹⁰ I make known the end from the beginning,
from ancient times, what is still to come.
I say, 'My purpose will stand,
and I will do all that I please.'
