Fire In His Eyes April 27, 2021 Suzi Armstrong

Our Father God has been calling us as deep calls to deep. If we are willing, He will take us deeper into His heart. He will reveal Himself to us in ways we have not seen or understood before. The book of Proverbs tells us that we can find the knowledge of God. We can know Him in a way that we have never known Him. Paul prays that God would give the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to Ephesian believers so that they would know Him better.

As a prophet I am telling you that we are in a time God wants us to know Him better. There are new dimensions, secrets, wisdom and revelation for this day that we are in. It is an equipping for the new era we are entering. This is a door into the future. It is knowledge that we need as we face things that we have not faced before. We need to think differently. See differently. Strategize differently. There is a rearranging on the inside of our hearts as we step into new knowledge – there is impartation and activation of what is needed. This is one of the most exciting times to be alive.

Revelation 1.12-14 NIV

¹²I turned around to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³and among the lampstands was someone like a **son of man**, dressed in a robe reaching down to his feet and with a golden sash around his chest. ¹⁴The hair on his head was white like wool, as white as snow, and **his eyes were like blazing fire.**

- John saw Jesus as the son of man, which is Jesus in His humanity. Hebrews 4.15 says Jesus understands our weaknesses because He was tempted in every way that we are – yet He was without sin.
- His eyes were blazing like fire.
- There is no separation between Jesus and the Father and we are united with Christ.
- We are at war – know who God is so we know who we are.
- We can do the things that Jesus did and even greater things.
- Our eyes are blazing with fire!!! This is the picture God wants us to have.
- Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you – it is blazing in your eyes. It identifies who you are and who you belong to. Nations will come to your light.

God is releasing revelation knowledge and understanding in this little phrase – “His eyes were like blazing fire.” Prophetically, what is God saying to us?

Matthew 6.22-23 NIV

²²“**The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light.** ²³But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!

- Eyes reflect the condition of the heart and the condition of your conscience.
- Your eyes are the gage of purity – fear, anger, hurt, joy, love, all show within the eyes.
- The blood of Jesus cleanses us and purifies us from all that contaminates.
- When Saul, who became Paul, encountered Jesus, God supernaturally delivered Saul by removing the scales from his eyes.

Hebrews 1.3 NIV

³ The Son is **the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being**, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven.

- In scripture Jesus says if you have seen Me you have seen the Father.
- In the beginning when God created man, the Bible tells us that He created man in His own image.

Hebrews 12.29 NIV

²⁹ for our **"God is a consuming fire."**

- When John saw Jesus as the Son of Man and there was fire in His eyes.
- God is showing us that He is in Jesus and nothing is blocking the fire and glory of His presence.

Psalm 97.1-3 NIV

¹ The Lord reigns, let the earth be glad;
let the distant shores rejoice.

² Clouds and thick darkness surround him;
righteousness and justice are the foundation of his throne.

³ Fire goes before him
and consumes his foes on every side.

¹⁷ Therefore, **if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come:** The old has gone, the new is here!

- There is a fire down in my soul that I can't contain that I can't control – I want more of You God...
- There is a fire on the inside of us that blazes in our eyes – it is visible to the enemy, it is visible to others.
- Stoke the fire blazing in your eyes through faith, passion, desire – setting your face like flint; keeping your eyes fixed on Jesus.
