John 14.6 NASB


⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the WAY, and the TRUTH, and the LIFE...

When you go to court, you swear or affirm to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing else but the truth. In the Kingdom of God, according to God's Kingdom.

Jesus is the TRUTH, the whole TRUTH and nothing else but the TRUTH.

The Word of God is the TRUTH the whole TRUTH and nothing but the TRUTH.

And God wants us to have CONFIDENCE to BELIEVE that every word He has spoken is TRUTH.

¹⁹ "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent; Has He said, and will He not do it? Or has spoken, and will He not make it good?"



CONFIDENCE – the feeling or belief that one can rely on someone or something. Firm trust, faith, the state of feeling certain about the truth of something.

Of course, as Kingdom believers we do not go by our feelings.

¹⁷ ...as it is written "The righteous shall live by faith."

So, it's not about what we see or feel, rather it's about what God has said.

¹⁴ Since we have this CONFIDENCE, we can also have great boldness before God, for if we ask anything agreeable to His will, He will hear us. ¹⁵ And if we know (have CONFIDENCE) that He hears us in whatever we ask, we also know (have CONFIDENCE) that we have obtained the requests we ask of Him.

Ephesians 3.12 TPT

¹² We have boldness through Him, and free access as kings before the Father because of our complete CONFIDENCE in Christ's faithfulness.

²⁵ You will not be subject to terror, for it will not terrify you. Nor will the disrespectful be able to push you aside, BECAUSE GOD IS YOUR CONFIDENCE in times of crisis, keeping your heart at rest in every situation.
