²⁸ So we are convinced that **every detail of our lives is continually woven together for good**, for we are his lovers who have been **called to fulfill his designed purpose**. ²⁹ For he knew all about us before we were born and he destined us from the beginning to **share the likeness of his Son**. This means the Son is the oldest among a vast family of brothers and sisters who will become just like him.

2. God can take hold of what is good and separate it out for His purposes. Genesis 1.3-4 NIV

³ And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. ⁴ **God saw that the light was good**, and **he separated** the light from the darkness.

3. Acknowledge and celebrate God because He is always good. Count and number His acts of goodness and do not forget any of His benefits. Psalm 32.11 TPT

¹¹ **So celebrate the goodness of God!** He shows this kindness to everyone who is his. Go ahead—shout for joy, all you upright ones who want to please him!

⁴As a result of this, **he has given you magnificent promises that are beyond all price**, so that through **the power of these tremendous promises** we can experience partnership with the divine nature, by which you have escaped the corrupt desires that are of the world.
