Trast That God Has Prepared You for This Jane 4, 2024 Sazi Armstrong

'Trust in the Lord with all your heart' is a huge command. It is reliance upon Yahweh in the four chambers of your heart, with your breath which gives life, with flow of your blood which is another dimension of life. Trust is speaking about the blood of Jesus shed for us on the cross which gives us EVERYTHING we need for life and godliness. We lack nothing – it is trusting that there is no lack in our lives. Our God has given us complete provision in every area of life – spiritual and physical. Trust that God has prepared you for what is happening – God has already prepared us. We need to trust that preparation and not let go. In the parable of the 10 virgins, half of them let go of the preparation God had given to them.

Trust creates the lens of our perception – we see through trusting. If we don't know what we are trusting in, it opens the door to fear. Trust creates a realm; it has substance. As we put our trust in God completely, it opens the door to receive the preparation that He has put in place. Trust is complete reliance upon God in the midst of the storm, in war, in the middle of everything that can be shaken that is being shaken, in the drama and shock of exposure of corruption, lies and manipulation in our civil government, in the judicial system, in schools, in business, in health, and more. Trust to stand your ground. What is our ground? It is truth as God sees and defines truth.

Trust flows into our thoughts and our thoughts frame our future. Trust is framing your future and the future of the next generations by what God has placed in them knowing that the good work that God begins He will also finish, even though the path may be unusual or even seem impossible in the natural. Paul came back to life after being stoned. Paul was not even impacted when a poisonous viper bit him. An angel came and released Peter from prison. Those who opposed the message John preached could not kill him even when they tried to boil him in oil. Elisha prayed and the eyes of his servant were opened to see that the angel armies of God far outnumbered the enemy. God parted the Red Sea and the Israelites walked through on dry ground. The 120 waited in the upper room when they had no idea what they were waiting for. And when Holy Spirit came with such power and demonstration the 120 did not back down but stepped into what God had prepared for them. All of this pictures trusting God and His preparation.
