### Psalm 42.6-8

<sup>6</sup> O my God, my soul is in despair within me; Therefore **I remember You** from the land of the Jordan, And the peaks of Hermon, from Mount Mizar. <sup>7</sup> **Deep calls to deep** at the sound of your waterfalls; All Your breakers and Your waves have rolled over me. <sup>8</sup> The LORD will command His loving-kindness in the daytime; And His song will be with me in the night, A prayer to the God of my life...

- The Lord has opened up doors to us.
- We worship corporately under an open heaven.
- Specific portals of heaven have opened for miracles.
- God has revealed that we are portals for life and heaven to travel through.

### Psalm 78.23-24

<sup>23</sup> *"Yet He had commanded the clouds above,  
And opened the doors of heaven,  
<sup>24</sup> Had rained down manna on them to eat,  
And given them of the bread of heaven."*

- Sunday, we heard from Dr. David, that God has opened up portals not for us to ascend and descend but for us to come up higher and sit with Him.
- In this we are learning how to discern and dwell in this special place.
- The air is thinner so there is a need for greater grace upon us to go there.
- We are taking hold of this specific grace.
- Revelation, revelation, revelation!

### Colossians 1.19-20

<sup>19</sup> For God in all his fullness **was pleased to live in Christ**, <sup>20</sup> and through him God reconciled **everything** to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross.





### John 17.21-24

<sup>21</sup> I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as **you are in me**, Father, and **I am in you**. And **may they be in us** so that the world will believe you sent me.

<sup>22</sup> “I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. <sup>23</sup> I am in them and you are in me. **May they experience such perfect unity** that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me. <sup>24</sup> Father, I want these whom you have given me to be with me where I am. Then they can see all the glory you gave me because you loved me even before the world began!

- What we have is more than just a stewardship. Stewardship is taking care of something for someone else.
- The Father is showing us His heart so that he can bring us into full Sonship with Christ.
- Unity with Him produces an inner knowing of the Father's heart.
- Breath for breath we will speak what he speaks and do what he is doing.
- He is taking us into the depths of Him so we become one with Him just as Christ is one with Him.
- Literally our heart will carry the sound of the Father.
- During Sunday worship I saw the inside of the Corporate man being flushed out, like being scrubbed new.
- It was like being fused with the heart of the Father as we cried Abbba! I belong to you!

### Psalm 133

<sup>1</sup> How wonderful and pleasant it is when brothers live together in harmony!

<sup>2</sup> For harmony is as precious as the anointing oil that was poured over Aaron's head, that ran down his beard and onto the border of his robe.

<sup>3</sup> Harmony is as refreshing as the dew from Mount Hermon that falls on the mountains of Zion.

And there the LORD has pronounced his blessing, even life everlasting.

- The harmony that God speaks of is the unity of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Just as they are three in one.
  - Build It Detroit.
  - Life Group.

### Luke 10.21-22

<sup>21</sup>In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. <sup>22</sup>All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the **Son chooses to reveal Him.**"

- All things handed over to Him – not stewardship but sonship.
- The Father and Son know each other intimately.
- We've been invited into that union.
- The Son chooses to reveal the Father to us.

### John 14.10

Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works.

### Genesis 1.26

Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

- God wanted a family. Knowing the Father's heart. Vast treasure. Intimacy.
- Must be filled with the Spirit to be in the Spirit.

### Hebrews 4.12

For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.


- The Word of God is the Father's shaping, correcting, molding, TRANSPLANTING His heart into our hearts.
- Separating our soul (self nature of man) from our spirit/heart creating a pure hearts.
- Pure hearts = pure motives.
- The heart of the Father is Spirit of Christ.

### Ezekiel 11.19

And I will **give them ONE HEART** and **A NEW SPIRIT** I will put within them. I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh. (soft, pliable).

### 1 Samuel 16.7


But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the LORD sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, **but the LORD looks on the heart.**"



### Ephesians 3.14-18

<sup>14</sup> For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, <sup>15</sup> **from whom every family** in heaven and on earth is named, <sup>16</sup> that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with **power through his Spirit in your inner being**, <sup>17</sup> **so that Christ may dwell in your hearts** through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup> may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth...

- There will be a greater desire for what He desires.
  - Example Husband and wife – begin to influence and shape one another.
- There will be a greater knowing what He knows.
- The Spirit of the One giving becomes the spirit of the one receiving.



### 1 Corinthians 2.10-16

<sup>10</sup> But it was to us that God revealed these things by his Spirit. For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God's deep secrets. <sup>11</sup> **No one can know a person's thoughts except that person's own spirit**, and no one can know God's thoughts except God's own Spirit. <sup>12</sup> **And we have received God's Spirit (not the world's spirit), so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us.**

<sup>13</sup> When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom. Instead, we speak words given to us by the Spirit, using the Spirit's words to explain spiritual truths. <sup>14</sup> But people who aren't spiritual can't receive these truths from God's Spirit. It all sounds foolish to them and they can't understand it, for only those who are spiritual can understand what the Spirit means. <sup>15</sup> Those who are spiritual can evaluate all things, but they themselves cannot be evaluated by others. <sup>16</sup> For, "Who can know the LORD's thoughts? **Who knows enough to teach him?" But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.**
