Isaiah 61.1-11 NIV reworded for Detroit

¹ **The Spirit of the Sovereign LORD is on you, Detroit,**
because the LORD has anointed His sons and daughters
to **proclaim good news** to your poor.
He has sent us to **bind up the brokenhearted,**
to **proclaim freedom** for the captives in every community and institution
and **release from darkness** for the prisoners,
² to **proclaim the year of the LORD's favor to you,** great city of Detroit
and the day of vengeance of our God,
to **comfort** all who mourn,
³ and **provide** for those who grieve in Detroit—
to **bestow** on them a crown of beauty
instead of ashes,
the oil of joy
instead of mourning,
and a garment of praise
instead of a spirit of despair.
The communities of Detroit will be called oaks of righteousness,
a planting of the LORD
for the display of his splendor.

⁴ Detroit your ancient ruins are being rebuilt
restoration is here in places long devastated;
Detroit you are being renewed
the devastation that has flourished here for generations is being removed.

⁵ Increase will come to your businesses;
creativity and witty inventions will flourish.

⁶ And **the sound of the LORD WILL BE RELEASED FROM THE CITY,**
you will bless the NAME of God.

New wealth will come to Detroit,
in the deliverance of your God you will boast.

⁷ Instead of the old shame
you will receive a double portion,
and instead of disgrace
you will rejoice in your inheritance in the Lord.
And so **your land will flourish and produce fruit,**
and joy will be in your streets.

⁸ "For I, the LORD, love justice;
I hate robbery and wrongdoing.
In my faithfulness I will reward my people
and make an everlasting covenant with them.

⁹ **Your influence and sound will be known among the nations, Detroit**
and their offspring among the peoples.

All who hear of Detroit will acknowledge
that they are a people the LORD has blessed."



¹⁰ The people of Detroit delight greatly in the LORD;
their souls rejoice in the One True God.
For **he has clothed Detroit with garments of salvation**
and set righteousness in the streets and institutions,
as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest,
and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

¹¹ For as the soil makes the sprout come up
and a garden causes seeds to grow,
so **the Sovereign LORD will make righteousness**
and praise spring up before all nations.
