Love That Abounds September 26, 2023 Suzi Armstrong

There is no force more powerful than the love of God. His love covers us and empowers us. His love moves mountains and conquers darkness. His love heals and delivers. His love sets the captives free. His love is contained in His promises. His love is carried in the substances of His words. His love fills our hearts and moves us to repentance. His love is real; it is tangible. His love is holy and righteous. His love – His unending supernatural love – is passionate and fiery.

Holy Spirit is emphasizing **ABOUNDING LOVE!** Why is that? Because God's love **ABOUNDS** – meaning it is strong, it is sustaining, it does not weaken, and it is more than we think that it is. Why do we need to know these qualities of God's love right now? Because the devil wants to make our heart grow weary in well doing. If that happens, we lose joy and then lose strength. God wants us to succeed in standing firm, succeed in breaking through, succeed in building, and succeed in advancing.

Success is the power to achieve and prosper. This is given by God. Deuteronomy 8 tells us that it is God that gives us the POWER to create wealth – prosper and succeed. Holy Spirit is saying that we need to know and connect to the supply of God's abounding love at this time. Be filled with His abounding love. Think on His love so that we are built up in our inner man. It is the inner man that leads the way to your future. The devil is trying to convince us that nothing is going to change – that is a lie! Don't lose the expectation that anything can change. The devil does not have eternal power. He cannot set things in firm foundations, only God can do that. Everything that the devil does is on a foundation of sand that shifts and does not hold together.

God's abounding love causes us to be clothed in His favor. Favor attracts success and success attracts favor. People gather around what is successful because God wants us to be successful. Let God's abounding love lead you on your path of victory. God's abounding love will keep you from being stuck and discouraged, thinking things are not going to change. The Lord says I KNOW the future that I have for you, for your family, for your city and I am able to bring you into it.

Psalm 103.8-12 NIV

- ⁸ The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, **abounding in love.**
- ⁹ He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever;
- ¹⁰ he does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.
- ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his love for those who fear him;
- ¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

The biblical meaning of "abound" is extreme or superabundance, beyond measure. Our Heavenly Father heaps an extraordinary amount of love on each and every one of us! His abounding love is love that extends itself beyond our ability to believe or even imagine. His love for us is infinite and immeasurable. God so loved the world that He gave Jesus to the world to save, deliver and redeem. There is no greater love. This is love that abounds – love that is never ending.

⁷ Those who are loved by God, let his love continually pour from you to one another, because God is love. Everyone who loves is fathered by God and experiences an intimate knowledge of him. ⁸ The one who doesn't love has yet to know God, for God is love. ⁹ The light of God's love shined within us when he sent his matchless Son into the world so that we might live through him. ¹⁰ This is love: He loved us long before we loved him. It was his love, not ours. He proved it by sending his Son to be the pleasing sacrificial offering to take away our sins.
