Jonathan David said:

John 4.13-14; 23-24

¹³ Jesus answered and said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again; ¹⁴ but **whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water** springing up to eternal life."

²³ But an hour is coming, and now is, when **the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth;** for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers.

²⁴ **God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."**

- Drinking the water Jesus gives changes our sound. It is like a tuning fork that recalibrates. Worship in spirit and in truth.
- Jesus said, the water I give you will become in you a well. You now have an inexhaustible supply of living water. Spring up o well!



John 7.37-38

³⁷ Now on the last day, the great *day* of the feast, **Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water.'"**

- When the river is flowing the enemy will be flushed out, what is hidden will be exposed and the enemy will be unseated.
- When the river of God is flowing out of us corporately it will cause the water level to rise in the streets, in the neighborhoods and the city. The river brings life. Let the water flow – exposing the enemy and bringing life.
- Lives will be changed. Circumstances will be changed. Life, life, life will pour into the city bringing transformation.
- Miraculous starts to flow.



Mark 1.32-34

³² When evening came, after the sun had set, they *began* bringing to Him all who were ill and those who were demon-possessed. ³³ And **the whole city had gathered at the door.** ³⁴ And **He healed many who were ill with various diseases, and cast out many demons;** and He was not permitting the demons to speak, because they knew who He was.

- The city is hungry.
- The city is crying out for life – crying out to be rebirthed, filled with hope.
- We carry the seed of re-birthing and Holy Spirit is overshadowing it. It is our time to see our neighborhood and city through God's eyes. It is time to hear the sound of heaven and release it into our city.
- This is a time of re-creating, bringing in the new, re-purposing and re-assigning.
- We are the vessel in which the supernatural from above can come and live within. Bringing heaven into the earth, into our city.



Acts 19.11-12

¹¹ **God was performing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul,** ¹² so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out.

- Ephesus was at the door.
- God performed miracles in Ephesus.

Ephesians 2.19-22

¹⁹ So then **you are** no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of **God's household**, ²⁰ having been **built** on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner *stone*, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is **growing into a holy temple in the Lord**, ²² in whom you also are **being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit**.

- This is the door the city of Ephesus was at. The door of the temple of God, not built by human hands but built by the Spirit of God.
- The door where life could be found.



Ephesians 4.29-30

²⁹ **Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths**, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. ³⁰ And **do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God**, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

- Guard your mouth. Only release the sound of heaven, the sound of life, the sound that builds and delivers, the sound that sets the captives free and the sound that heals, the sound that brings in restoration and wholeness.
- This is the sound of heaven over the city.

Ephesians 4.22-24

²² You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to **put off your old self**, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; ²³ to **be made new in the attitude of your minds**; ²⁴ and to **put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness**.

Proverbs 11.9-11

⁹ With *his* mouth the godless man destroys his neighbor, But through knowledge the righteous will be delivered.

¹⁰ **When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices,**

And when the wicked perish, there is joyful shouting.

¹¹ **By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted,** But by the mouth of the wicked it is torn down.

2 Corinthians 2.14-17

¹⁴ But thanks be to God, who always **leads us in triumph in Christ**, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place. ¹⁵ For **we are a fragrance of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing**; ¹⁶ to the one an aroma from death to death, to the other an aroma from life to life. And who is adequate for these things? ¹⁷ For we are not like many, peddling the word of God, but as from sincerity, but as from God, **we speak in Christ** in the sight of God.

- The city is at our door.
- We are the fragrance of Christ in our city – to one life and to another death.
- This is not in ourselves but we speak in Christ. Not our agenda but speaking the heart of God, releasing the sound of heaven.

2 Corinthians 4.4-6

⁴ in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. ⁵ For **we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord**, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. ⁶ **For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light** of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ.

Zechariah 2.4b-5

^{4b} Jerusalem will be a city without walls because of the great number of people and animals in it. ⁵ And **I myself will be a wall of fire around it, declares the LORD, and I will be its glory within.**
