Divine hope is infused with an indispensable quality that enables us to lay hold of the future and boldly advance. It opens our eyes to see what cannot be seen without hope. It is the quality that connects us to our future. Hope is core to the spiritual war that we are in right now in our city and nation.

Hebrews 11.1 NKJV

¹ Now faith is the substance [realization] of **things hoped for,** the evidence [confidence] of things not seen.

Hope is a spiritual entity, meaning it is something that exists. It is tangible in the spirit realm. Hope speaks; it has a narrative that frames your future – it creates a gateway that you walk through and connects you to resources to build your future. Hope has a governing dynamic that guides you into the future. Receive the truth of hope and the fullness of all that comes with it in your heart of hearts. Hope filters and guides your steps. Hope advances and builds. Hope is a dynamic that you walk in and conform to. Our lives are shaped by the hope that we hold. Intentionally give yourself to the hope of God.

God put hope in Abraham's heart. Hope for a future that was beyond the land of Ur of the Chaldees. When hope is implanted, faith comes with it. Abraham believed God and it was credited to him as righteousness. When Abraham parted ways with his cousin Lot, God told Abraham to lift his eyes and look from where you are and see what I have for you. God is saying that same thing to us and to our city – there is hope that God has instilled in your heart. Let that hope be formed and defined by Holy Spirit. Unite with the hope of God – that hope forms a gateway to your future. Renew your mind through hope. Hope rooted in the world contains corruption and condemnation. Every word that is being spoken out of the systems of the world is filled with an agenda – most often a political agenda. Your hope cannot be filled with the promises of culture or anything that would be sourced in the current world system. The world system is not sustainable – it has many flaws; many agendas, and it is filled with works of darkness.
