Not A Time To Tolerate the Lies June 25, 2024 Suzi Armstrong

Isaiah 54.17 NIV

¹⁷No weapon forged against you will prevail, and **you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me," declares the LORD.**

- This is a promise of God that no weapon formed against us will overcome us. Why? Because of the blood of Jesus.
- Stand strong in the Lord's promise and know that God is with you.
- We are to refute every accusation – we release the breath of God; life is in the breath.
 - Refute means to prove wrong by evidence or argument.
 - What is our argument? The promise and provision of God.
 - A lot of accusations are being thrown at Christians. Do not be silent – release the breath. This speaking back will often be in your home or your car, not to a person.
 - We are speaking to powers and principalities and rulers of wickedness.
 - Do not let these false accusations remain without being called out as false or erroneous.

This is not a time to tolerate the lies of darkness. It is not a time to be silent. Speak truth – release the breath of God through speaking truth. Adam came to life because God breathed the breath of life into him. Ezekiel was commanded to prophesy to the breath and the breath of God entered the dry bones and they came to life. In Isaiah 42 the Lord says, for a long time I have kept silent, I have been quiet and held Myself back, but now, like a woman in childbirth, I cry out, I gasp and pant. This is the beginning of the roar of the Lion of Judah. Release the truth – refute the lies, speak truth out. This is not a place of reasoning, for this is not of the natural world system but a supernatural sound – the frequency of Heaven, the breath of the Lord filled with dimensions of the Kingdom of God. As the Ekklesia, we are filled with the sound of Heaven. Be alert for the fake sound filled with lies of intimidation that prowls like a roaring lion seeking to devour and fill you with chaos and confusion.
