 - They are visible through the eyes of faith.
 - Through trusting God and not leaning on our own understanding of what we think or feel in our emotions.
 - By faith we align with the heart of God, not persuaded of our future through the scripting of media but know the times and seasons by revelation of Holy Spirit.
 - Aligned in expectation of where our help comes from – knowing where our supply comes from.
 - There is a WAY of prosperity, wholeness and hope that banishes despair and destruction. Light dispels darkness.

Through our union with Christ we too have been claimed by God as his own inheritance. Before we were even born, **he gave us our destiny; that we would fulfill the plan of God** who always accomplishes every purpose and plan in his heart.

John 15.4-7 TPT

⁴ So **you must remain in life-union with me, for I remain in life-union with you.** For as a branch severed from the vine will not bear fruit, so **your life will be fruitless unless you live your life intimately joined to mine.**

⁵ "I am the sprouting vine and you're my branches. **As you live in union with me as your source, fruitfulness will stream from within you**—but when you live separated from me you are powerless.

⁶ If a person is separated from me, he is discarded; such branches are gathered up and thrown into the fire to be burned. ⁷ But **if you live in life-union with me and if my words live powerfully within you—then you can ask whatever you desire and it will be done.**
